

## Easy Bird Feeder

## You will need:

- Bowl
- String or ribbon
- Paint
- Paint brushes

- Wild bird food
- 1 Carrot
- 1 Slice of bread
- 1 Block of lard
- Tin can with ring pull or plastic bottle

## MAKING THE BIRD FOOD



- 1. Tear the slice of bread into small pieces
- 2. Grate the carrot
- 3. Place the bread into the bowl first and then add the wild bird seed and grated carrot. Mix well.
- 4. Cut the lard into thick slices and put it in the bowl with the seed etc.
- 5. Using your hands, squash the seeds, carrot etc. into the lard



6. Mould the mixture so that it will fit inside the tin can or bottle

## PREPARING YOUR TIN CAN FEEDER

1. Using your clean tin can (be very careful there are no sharp edges) or bottle, paint this in any colour or design.

You can add patterns or pictures.



- 2. When the paint has dried, tie your string or ribbon around each end of the can.
- 3. Then fill your bird feeder with the mixture.



4. Hang the bird feeder outside and enjoy watching the birds feeding!
